MEMORANDUM For Those Concerned

Subject: Trip to Langley to attend Inspection

1. Persons listed on the attached sheet are invited to go to the Langley Aeronautical Laboratory on the date indicated to attend the Langley Inspection.

2. Passengers should be at the hangar, ready to board the airplane, by 5:30 a.m. E.D.T. The airplane will take off at 5:45 a.m. sharp and proceed directly to Langley, arriving at approximately 8:15 a.m. The inspection will start at 8:35 a.m. E.D.T. and will end at 5:00 p.m. The airplane will depart as soon as practicable after the end of the inspection and proceed directly to the Lewis laboratory. Parachutes should be fitted by the passengers the afternoon before they depart and marked with their name, in order to save time in the morning.

3. Because of the shortage of travel funds, no per diem or expenses will be allowed. Personnel making this trip will be on official travel status with no allowances.

4. Fruit juice, coffee, and donuts will be available on the plane at a cost of \$.30 per person.
